Thank you for your patience as staff has worked to assess your request. Please see the below responses in red to each numbered item of your request.

1) Please provide a complete and accurate list of ALL findings presented to the City, whether from City staff or City hired contractors such as Veolia, within the past 60 days regarding the horrendous smells that have been so prevalent on the west side of the City, including the Highlands. **No responsive records exist. The City considers this request to be closed.**

2) Regarding all of the water issues on west side of the City including the Highlands, specifically related to the drinking and waste water, please provide a complete and accurate list of ALL residents who have contacted the City with complaints within the past 60 days and also those who have been provided insurance claim numbers. **In regards to your request for a list of residents who have contacted the City and lodged complaints and for a list of residents or complaints that have been provided insurance claim numbers, no responsive records exist. Further, claims files, including insurance claim numbers, are confidential and exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution until termination of all litigation and settlement of all claims arising out of the same incident pursuant to F.S. 768.28(16)(b). The City considers this request to be closed.**

3) The name of the Insurance Company retained by the City that would be responsible for any such claims. Please also include the insurance company's phone number, address and agent phone number. **This request is denied as it does not seek inspection or copying of an existing public record. The City considers this request to be closed.**
